## Jackson North Wind Farm Indicative Approval Process

## Equis will seek primary development and environmental approvals from both the Queensland State and Commonwealth Governments.

## State Assessment and Approval Process

The Project will apply for a Material Change of Use (Wind Farm) and Operational Work (Vegetation Clearing) Development Permits through the State Assessment and Referral Agency (SARA). The application process will evaluate the environmental, social, and engineering impacts of the development to ensure that individuals, communities, and the environment are not adversely affected during the construction, operation, and decommissioning of the Project.

## **Commonwealth Assessment and Approval Process**

The Project will be referred to the Commonwealth Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) for approval under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act). This process will focus on assessing impacts on Matters of National Environmental Significance (MNES) to ensure that all known federally listed flora and fauna are adequately protected throughout the project's construction, operation, and decommissioning phases.
